

The Shelby County Fair Talent Show is open to contestants from all areas but each act must have a minimum number of contestants that live in Shelby County. A five person act must have a minimum of three members from Shelby County; a three or four person act must have at least two members from Shelby County; duos must have one member from Shelby County.

No more than five persons are allowed in one act. Piano accompanist is not included toward the member limit for vocal performers. No more than three piano accompanists permitted per act. Drums, amps, etc are discouraged due to limited set up time. No combos, rock bands or similar musical groups permitted. **Contestants need to provide their own keyboard, if necessary, and should check with show coordinator well before the show to make sure the keyboard will be compatible with the sound system.**
